Oh it is so hot here in Banning now, I golfed this AM and we started at 08:00 AM finished at about 10:00 and it felt so good to get in the shower and cool off!

We have been busy taking care of Jac, he did well during his surgery and the recovery, but it had spread in the area, they cleaned it up, but he will have the follow up of a low iodine diet for about 2 - 3 weeks, and then be given the radio active iodine. to destroy the cancer cells if any has escaped into the system. His voice was affected after the surgery, but he has elected to get an injection to help restore it to normal, it has to be repeated about every 6 months.

He goes on the 31st to get the small skin squamous cell cancer removed. Then the following day to Oral surgeon to check a lesion under his tongue!

We chatted with J R the other day, he had a flat on the truck so he was in the process of fixing it. He has been keeping all his Dr.'s appointments. He really misses you. Everybody does, I can't say it enough.

Shelly and I had a nice long conversation the other day. I am hoping we can take a trip this fall. I have to figure it out!
