Albert "Ralph" Clark was born December 19, 1933, in Baltimore, Maryland. He graduated from The Johns Hopkins University with a Bachelor of Science in Engineering and relocated from Baltimore to Dallas, TX in 1966. Ralph worked for over 50 years in consumer product and Robotic system design for various companies: Recognition Equipment, Bendix Corp., Xerox, Meade Corp., Storage Technologies, Venture Engineering and Spectra Technologies, before retiring in 2002. During his career, Ralph was awarded two U.S. patents and held various engineering and management positions, including V.P of Engineering and V.P. of Sales and Marketing.

Ralph has been a Christian and church member for over 35 years and has taught Bible Study classes, served on church finance, budget and facility committees.
