' Allen "Don" Bobino was born October 17, 1933, in Beaumont, Texas, to Alton Dean and Eula Mae (Goodeau) Bobino. He died Wednesday, April 1, 2015, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 81 years. Don was reared and educated in Tulsa and graduated with the East Central High School Class of 1954. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Marine Corps. He was married February 8, 1957 in Arkansas, to Leanna Fields. Don spent most of his working life as a deputy sheriff with the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office. He later worked security for American Airlines in Tulsa.
