' Anthony Francis "Tony" Cavallo, Jr, resident of Owasso, passed from this life on Saturday, September 13, 2014 at the age of 65 years. Tony was born July 25, 1949 in Brooklyn, New York to Anthony Francis and Bruna Carmella (Vitiello) Cavallo. He was raised and received his education in New York, graduating high school from Half Hollow in Huntington, NY. Tony continued his education, by receiving his business degree from the New York Institute of Technology. On August 31, 1974, Tony and Marilyn Jean Wride were united in marriage in Athens, Georgia. He served in the U.S. Navy from October 1971 until he was honorably discharged on May 15, 1980. He and Marilyn resided in Norfolk, VA until returning to Brooklyn.
