Archie Lee Horton was born March 22, 1943, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Lodebar Archibald "L.A." and Osa Bell Toothman Horton. He died Thursday, November 28, 2019, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 76 years. Archie completed his secondary education in Collinsville, Oklahoma, and was graduated with the Collinsville High School Class of 1961. He was married June 9, 1961, in Collinsville to Verna Mae Wedel. Archie attended Nazarene Bible College in Colorado Springs, Colorado, where he completed his biblical and theological studies. He served several pastorates in the Nazarene church from 1968 through 1990. He pastored churches in Hopkinsville, Kentucky, Francisco, Indiana, Middleton, Nova Scotia, Canada, Stephenville, Newfoundland, Canada, Elmsdale, Prince Edward Island, Canada, Grand Prairie, Alberta Canada, Parkview Nazarene Church in Tulsa, and in Grove, Oklahoma. 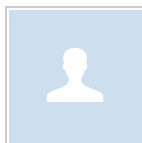
