Betty Jean Ward was born on April 10, 1937, in Claremore, Oklahoma, to Tommy Cox and Bonnie Pearl (Brown) Siens. She grew up near Afton, Oklahoma, where she excelled in school and graduated as Valedictorian of the Afton High School Class of 1955. Even as a young woman, Betty carried herself with a quiet determination and a deep love for people — qualities that would define her entire life.

In 1959, she married the love of her life, Carl Ray Ward, at First Baptist Church in Tulsa. Together they built a life rooted in faith, hard work, and unwavering devotion to their family. Betty began her career in insurance in 1955 in Tulsa, and her talent and work ethic carried her to Denver, Colorado, where she continued her career with Farmers Insurance. After returning to Oklahoma in 1993, she joined Fred Daniel and Sons in 1994 — a job she cherished so much that she continued working until the age of 80.

Betty's faith community was a meaningful part of her life. She loved attending the JOY Sunday School class at Freedom Church and found purpose in the Helping Hands Bible study group, where she enjoyed fellowship and serving others. She organized craft shows for the ladies' ministry, often filling the room with her floral arrangements and Home Interiors décor. Creativity came naturally to her, and she delighted in sharing it with others.

She also treasured time with her friends, meeting monthly to play games and laugh together. She loved teaching her family the games she learned, turning simple moments into cherished memories. But perhaps nothing brought her

more joy than cooking and hosting. Sunday dinners and holiday gatherings were her specialty — moments when her home was filled with the warmth of family, good food, and the kind of fellowship she loved most.
