' Billie Ann (Miller) Simpson, age 87, of Collinsville, went to be with The Lord on Tuesday, November 25, 2014, in Tulsa. Billie was born February 9, 1927, to William E. and Donella Dee (Greenlee) Miller at Wynona, OK. She was raised in Wynona, Skiatook and later Seminole, OK, where she graduated high school in 1945. On July 5, 1946, Billie and Wayne Simpson were united in marriage in Ada, OK. To this union, two children were born.
