Bobbie Lee Turner was born May 25, 1935, in Owasso, Oklahoma, to Fred Arlando Turner and Hazel Cornelia Crumpton Turner. He died Wednesday, December 13, 2023, in Owasso at the age of 88 years. Bobbie was a lifelong resident of Owasso where he attended school and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1954. While in high school, he was active with the Future Farmers of America and served as the first Chapter President. He also participated in basketball and football during the time Owasso was known as the Owls.
