Bobby Gene Puckett was born February 12, 1936, in Keota, Oklahoma, to Curtis and Agnes Puckett. He died Wednesday, September 18, 2019, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 83 years. Bob was married April 30, 1955, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Barbara Jane Cole. They had made their home in Owasso since 1968. He began at Tulsair in an entry level position on February 2, 1956. He quickly worked his way through the ranks becoming a pilot and retiring on February 2, 2001, as Vice President. 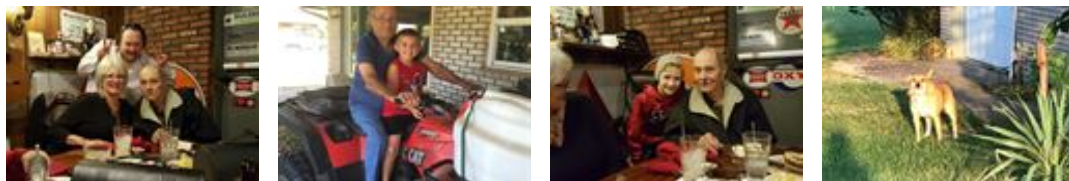
