Caden Chance DuBose, 20 years old, from Owasso, Oklahoma was freed from the chains of addiction by his Lord on June 11th, 2019 in Costa Mesa, California.

Cade was born October 16th, 1998 the first born son of Chance & Donna (Head) DuBose. Cade grew up and went to school in Owasso. He also attended Central Baptist Church as a kid. Cade wrestled, played baseball, and football. His other hobbies included riding his motorcycle, driving his moms challenger, fishing, hunting, and shooting guns. He loved spending time at the family farm. Cade also had a knack for movies & movie quotes. Cade had a way with babies and would be as silly as he could in order to make them laugh. Cade had no fear. He was always the first in line for white water rafting, bungee jumping, and bull riding.

People, who really knew Cade, knew him as funny, compassionate, and giving. He was a protector of anyone he loved, including his friends who he loved as family. No one plans on becoming an addict; Cade was always searching for help and never gave up hope of recovery. He knew he was worth so much more and wanted to be great. His dream was to become a welder, just like his Grandad.

Cade is survived by his parents, Chance and Donna (Head) DuBose of

Owasso; his sister Carson DuBose & his brother Joel DuBose. Nana Carol Roe from Shidler, Papa Rick DuBose of Turley. His girl friend, Jessica Arbuckle of Owasso and many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.

A huge part of this family died when Cade left this earth. The pain of Cade's death is unbearable but as a family our goal is to remove the fear, shame, and stigma of mental illness and addiction. We ask that we all make a conscious decision to come together, love, and forgive each other... no matter what.
