' Carolyn Kay (Moore) McIntosh of Tulsa was born to Freeman Chalmer and Essie Ola (Wharton) Moore on December 20, 1945 in Clarksville, Texas. She was the second born of twin girls. They moved from Bogota, TX to Oklahoma in 1959. Carolyn gave her heart to Jesus in 1963, and had followed him joyfully the remainder of her days. She was a graduate of Tulsa Central High School (Downtown) in 1964. Carolyn had met Donald R. McIntosh at a church camp in Tulsa in June of 1965. After much prayer, they were united in marriage on November 23, 1968; to this union three children were born. Carolyn's priority in life, besides serving her savior, was to be a wife, mother and grandmother. She enjoyed playing Bunco, collecting Nutcracker figurines and playing games with her family. Carolyn passed from this life on Sunday, January 31, 2016 at the age of 70 years.
