'Jon Casey Goodson was born July 13, 1975 in San Francisco, California to Lawrence "Butch" and Marsha Lynn (Combs) Goodson. He died October 6, 2016, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 41 years. Casey graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1994 and then went on to earn his Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from the University of Oklahoma in Norman, Oklahoma and his Doctorate from Cleveland Chiropractic College in Kansas City, Missouri.
