



## Christopher Eugene Boston

January 30, 1977 - November 3, 2025

Christopher Eugene Boston was born January 30, 1977 in Washington DC, the son of Richard Maurice Boston and Barbara Elaine Clinesmith Boston. Chris passed away on November 3, 2025 in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 48 after having a stroke.

Chris was raised in Maryland and graduated from Annapolis Area Christian School in 1995.

He attended Houghton College in Houghton, New York and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in secondary education in 1999.

He taught eighth grade social studies at Neelsville Middle School in Germantown, Maryland, for a few years. As teachers want their students to succeed, Chris went beyond that. He told students, if they were willing to study and put in the effort, he would gladly write a brand-new test for them to take.

A few years later, Chris enlisted in the United States Navy. He was an outstanding graduate from the Operational Intelligence Analyst "C" School in June 2008 and served honorably until his discharge in about 2017.

Chris then attended Miramar College, in San Diego, California, where he trained to be a Toyota mechanic. He was then able to work at Toyota of Poway, California.

When the family then moved to Oklahoma, Chris first worked for an insurance company and then on an assembly line producing commercial construction vehicles for Ramsey Industries in Tulsa.

Chris loved soccer, lacrosse, the Washington Redskins, video games, pizza, and the family's dog, Rio.

Chris also enjoyed hard work. His most recent boss said that he could count on Chris to complete any task assigned on time and with excellence.

Chris was the quiet type who preferred to keep to himself, but he loved his mother and expressed it through his actions — putting thoughtful gestures in place as his way of showing how much he loved her.

He also registered to donate his organs upon his passing, again without telling his family. This precious gift resulted in help and hope for three people who needed organs and several others that received tissue.

Christopher is survived by his mother Barbara and his sister, Deborah McKay, of Owasso. He was preceded in death by his brother, Patrick McIntyre, in 1992, and by his father, Richard Boston in 2021.
