' Clarence Jefferson Thompson was born November 26, 1924, in Henryetta, Oklahoma, to Albert Jefferson and Pauline Sallie Watts Thompson. He died Friday, December 29, 2017, in Edmond, Oklahoma, at the age of 93 years. Clarence was reared on a farm in Wann, Oklahoma, educated in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and was a graduate of Crooked Oak High School. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably as a flight engineer and bombardier with the United States Air Force during World War II, completing 31 bombing missions over enemy territory. He was married June 12, 1948, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to Edna Marie Hunter Thompson. They had made their home in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in 1954, before moving to Owasso, Oklahoma, in 1959.
