



Clinton "Clint" Wade Beeson

July 13, 1969 - June 15, 2025

Dr. Clinton Beeson, a devoted husband, father and respected medical professional, passed away on June 15, 2025 at Saint Francis Hospital. He was 55 years old.

Born with a natural curiosity and a heart for healing, Dr. Beeson dedicated his life to caring for others through medicine. But it was outside the hospital walls- under open skies, among mountain trails, or by a quiet river- that he found his deepest peace. He had a true love for the outdoors and found great joy handcrafting knives for his friends.

On March 12, 2007 he married the love of his life, Nicole Burton. Together they built a life of ornery shenanigans, laughter and adventure. But it was the arrival of their children that truly lit his soul. Becoming a father was his greatest joy and he spoke of his desire to share his love of golfing and kayaking with the two of them.

Dr. Beeson will be remembered not only for his clinical skill and quiet strength but also for his honesty, integrity and persistence in ensuring the best care and provision for his patients and ones he loves.

Preceded in death by his brother Troy, the two are now reunited in the Colorado mountains.

He is survived by his wife, Nicole, their beloved children, Irelynd and Quinton; his parents Dennis and Bette Beeson, brother Dustin Beeson and many extended family and friends who will carry his memory forward with love and gratitude.

Services will be held at Nickell Memorial Chapel in Hazel Valley, Arkansas on June 28th at 2:00pm.

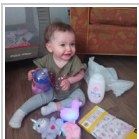
