April 1, 1943 - April 29, 2018

Dave Austin Duncan was born April 1, 1943, in Alpena, Michigan, to Roy Austin and Norma Faye Allison Duncan. He died Sunday, April 29, 2018, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 75 years. After graduation from school, Dave continued his education attending Cameron University in Lawton, Oklahoma, where he earned his Bachelor of Science degree.
