' Donald Ray Meredith was born October 21, 1931, in Mount Carmel, Illinois, to Manvil Warren and Della Allen (Creasey) Meredith. He died Wednesday, August 17, 2016, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 84 years. Don completed his secondary education in Haubstadt, Indiana, and graduated with the Haubstadt High School Class of 1949. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Navy. He was married March 14, 1954, at Antioch Christian Church in Keensburg, Illinois, to Vera Marie Mowery. They moved to Tulsa, Oklahoma, where Don attended Spartan School of Aeronautics. After graduation he accepted a job with American Airlines where he worked for 38 years before retiring as an inspector. Both Don and Vera rededicated their lives to God in August of 1954 and were baptized at Immanuel Baptist Church in Tulsa.
