Dorothy Jean Webber Freeman was born May 23, 1934, in Shattuck, Oklahoma, to Joseph Douglas McDaniel and Elsie Elma Smtih McDaniel. She died Sunday, February 2, 2025, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 90 years. Dorothy completed her secondary education in Gage, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Gage High School Class of 1952.
