She was preceded in death by her parents; husband John George Ward; son John H. Ward, Sr.; and granddaughter Rachael N. Dobyms.

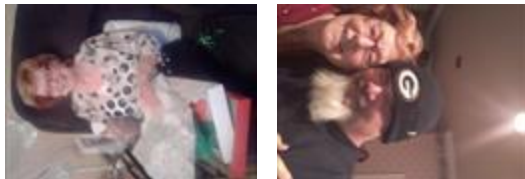
