Earl Gene Spickelmier was born May 28, 1928, in Owasso, Oklahoma, to Harold Gordon Spickelmier and Devedia Ann Draper. He died Saturday, March 16, 2024, in Owasso at the age of 95 years. Earl was reared and educated in Owasso and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1946. During his high school years he played basketball for Owasso, who at the time were known as the Owls. Earl was a veteran of the armed services having served his country honorably with the United States Navy during World War II. Earl was married March 5, 1954, in Owasso, Oklahoma, to Ruth Pavey. He spent most of his professional career as a supervisor with Southwestern Bell before his retirement. Earl was a longtime faithful member of First Baptist Church of Owasso.
