Eddie Dale White, age 84 of rural Claremore, passed from this life on Thursday, April 6, 2023 at his home.

Eddie was born on January 14, 1939 in Okmulgee to J.E and Ruby (Jackson) White. He was raised and received his education in the Twin Hills area of Okmulgee County. Upon graduating high school, Eddie attended Northeastern State College in Tahlequah where he received his bachelor's degree.
