Elgin Weaver Harris was born August 24, 1934, in Chester, Oklahoma, to David Cole and Ivory Beck Harris. He died Sunday, April 23, 2017, in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, at the age of 82 years. Elgin completed his secondary education in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Pawhuska High School Class of 1953. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Air Force. He was married May 11, 1955, in Shidler, Oklahoma, to Colene Clifford. They made the move to Collinsville, Oklahoma, Thanksgiving weekend in 1975. Elgin spent most of his working life as an avionics technician with the 138th Air National Guard in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
