She was 99 years of age. Evelyne was born July 2, 1916, in Trego County, Kansas, to Joseph and Fannie (Rezak) Littlechild. She was raised and received her education in WaKeeney, Kansas. On June 22, 1935, she and Walter August Tegtmeyer were united in marriage in WaKeeney. To this union, four children were born. During their married life, they made their home in both Colorado and northwest Kansas. Walter preceded her in death on December 13, 1990, at which time, they had been married for 54 years.
