Alfredo “Freddie” James Aragon was born September 17, 1959, in Los Angeles, California, to Alfredo Horceo Aragon and Gloria T. (Vela) Aragon. He passed from this life on Wednesday, April 17, 2019, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 59 years. 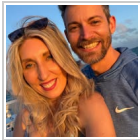
