Freddie Lee Hampton was born April 25, 1942, in St. Joseph, Missouri, to Fred H. and Mary Lee Hall Hampton. He died Sunday, February 17, 2019, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 76 years. Fred completed his secondary education in Owasso, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1960. He continued his education attending Tulsa Junior College.
