Gary Ray Edwards was born April 9, 1946, in Orange, California, to Mearl Marine and Dora Elizabeth McElhaney Edwards. He died Friday, November 5, 2021, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 75 years. Gary was reared and educated in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Nathan Hale High School Class of 1964.
