' Gary Lee Osburn, resident of Talala, OK, passed from this life on Thursday, July 3, 2014 at the age of 66 years. Gary was born June 4, 1948 in Yakima, Washington to William and Margaret (Coxon) Osburn. He was raised and received his education in the Hoyt and Stigler area of Oklahoma, graduating Stigler high school in 1966. As a proud American, Gary later enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving honorably in Vietnam and receiving both a Purple Heart and a Bronze Star. He also received the National Defense Service medal, Vietnam Campaign medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Army Commendation medal and Good Conduct medal.
