Gary Joe Walker, 81, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family members on Saturday, March 30, 2024, in Brownsville, Texas. Joe was born February 27, 1943, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Berneice and William Alec Walker. He was preceded in death by his parents, and two brothers, Barry Allen Walker and Dennis Alec Walker. He is survived by his loving wife of over 60 years, Pauline Walker, daughter Jodi Madison, son and daughter-in-law David and Jobelle Walker, five grandchildren, April Madison, Austin, Madison, Alexis Madison, Kody Madison, Billy Walker, and four great grandchildren, May McCarty, StevieJune McCarty, Gypsi McCarty, Walker Madison, sister Joy Compton, brother and sister-in-law Scotty and Lynn Walker, sister-in-law, Maryellen Lindsay, and numerous nieces and nephews.

Joe was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Navy during the Viet Nam war. Joe volunteered during his retirement for five years as a Reserve Deputy with the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office with most of that time serving on the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Drug Task Force. During this time, Joe was honored as the Reserve Deputy of the Year. After leaving his volunteer job, he and Pauline moved to Brownsville, Texas, where they had lived for almost 11 years. Joe enjoyed two beloved hobbies. He owned and showed old cars throughout his life as well as judging many car shows in Tulsa and across

several states. Joe also loved and participated in quarter mile drag boat racing over the years. In Brownsville, he has enjoyed driving and showing his Roadster.
