Glen Urban "Tub" Sieben was born July 4, 1935, in West Township, Illinois to Clarence William Sieben and Gladys Claudine Hinkle Sieben. He died Friday, April 19, 2024, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 88 years. Glen completed his secondary education in Altamont, Illinois, and was a graduate of Altamont High School. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served his country honorably with the United States Army. Glen was married May 14, 1955, in Edgewood, Illinois, to Shirley Ann Caroline Bergman.
