Jack Edward Little, Jr., was born January 28, 1942, in Cairo, Illinois, to Jack Edward and Willis Geraldine Cooper Little. He died Sunday, March 18, 2018, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 76 years. Jack was reared and educated in Muskogee, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Muskogee High School Class of 1960. He continued his education attending Northeastern Oklahoma State University in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. He was married November 4, 1963, in Sapulpa, Oklahoma, to Marilyn Avis Thompson.
