Jane Lorene Green was born March 18, 1931, in Inola, Oklahoma, to Charles Grant Spurlock and Ethel Nees Spurlock. She died Tuesday, August 19, 2025, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 94 years. Jane completed her secondary education in Inola, Oklahoma, and was a graduate of Inola High School. She was married June 14, 1953, in Inola, to Clarence Franklin Green. Clarence served in the Air Force, and they moved around while he was in the service. They had made their longtime home in Ketchum, Oklahoma, where he served as Superintendent of Ketchum Public Schools. It was during this time she provided childcare for many children of the Ketchum school teachers.

Jane was a strong woman of faith. She was active in the First Baptist Church at Ketchum teaching Sunday School classes and working with the Lottie Moon Ministries.
