Janice Alliene (Reed) Hall was born February 19, 1943, in Elk City, Kansas, to Sammie Fowler Reed and Leatha Alliene McCarty. She died Thursday, May 7, 2026, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at the age of 83 years.

Janice grew up in Elk City, Kansas, graduating with the Elk City High School Class of 1961. She married her high school sweetheart, Gene Hall, on November 1, 1961. Janice and Gene made their home in Owasso, Oklahoma, where they raised their family. Janice spent her professional career working with Owasso Public Schools as a secretary in the athletics office and the administration office.

Janice lived out a life of faith through her commitment to Christ as demonstrated by her love for Scripture and faithful prayer life. She was a member of Owasso Silver Creek Church of the Nazarene where she taught children and adult Sunday School classes. She also served on the Northeast Oklahoma District Church of the Nazarene Advisory Board and Missions Council.
