Jennifer Lee Swarer, 41, of Coweta, Oklahoma, passed away on January 2, 2025, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer, surrounded by her loving family and friends.

Born on December 9, 1983, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Johnny Lloyd Swarer and Joy Lenora (Lee) Miller. She was raised in Coweta, where she enjoyed a joyful and simple childhood, spending time gardening and canning with her Granny and Papa Lee, Sunday dinners, playing softball, and making lifelong friendships.

Jennifer was a proud graduate of Coweta High School, Class of 2002, and was a dedicated member of the Coweta FFA. Her involvement in FFA included holding numerous officer positions and earning many accolades, such as the Greenhand Degree, winning an essay contest, Breed Champion with her hog projects and her State FFA Degree. Her hard work, dedication, and leadership made a lasting impact on her chapter and her community.

Jennifer's pursuit of education led her to earn an Associate of Science degree from Tulsa Community College, followed by a Bachelor's degree in Finance from Oklahoma State University. Her dedication to service and justice inspired her to pursue another degree—a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from Purdue Global.

Jennifer found her true calling in law enforcement, dedicating the last 16 years of her life to the Catoosa Police Department. Her dedication to her career was evident in her many accomplishments, including receiving the Medal of Valor

and becoming the first female officer promoted beyond the rank of Corporal at the department, in addition to the Marksman Award, Sharpshooter Award, Intermediate Certification Award, Bachelor's Degree Award, Advanced Certification Award, Good Conduct Award, Field Training Officer Designation, Meritorious Conduct Award (twice), Life Saving Award, Police Chief's Commendation for service during and throughout the Covid 19 pandemic and the Distinguished Service Award, awarded this past December for continued service while fighting the battle of her life. She couldn't be present during the awards ceremony and never knew she earned this award. Despite her significant achievements, Jennifer remained humble and focused on serving others. Her humility and devotion earned the admiration of colleagues and the gratitude of the community she served.

Beyond her career, Jennifer had a deep love for animals, particularly her cats and her beloved guard rooster, Earl—if you know the Dixie Chicks song, you're just as surprised as us that he's still crowing. Her heart was full of love for her family, friends, and community.

Above all, Jennifer's greatest pride and joy was her daughter, Jaidyn, whom she welcomed into the world in 2011. Jaidyn was the light of her life, and Jennifer's role as a mother brought her immeasurable happiness. She loved watching Jaidyn play softball and cherished the moments spent laughing and enjoying life with her daughter and friends.

As a child, Jennifer attended the First Christian Church in Coweta. More recently, she attended the Coweta Assembly of God. She was a loyal friend to many and known for her selflessness, willingness to help others, and her unwavering support of those in need. Her colleagues at the Catoosa Police Department remember her as a compassionate, courageous, and steadfast officer who inspired those around her.

Jennifer is survived by her parents, John and Joy Miller, her cherished daughter, Jaidyn, all of Coweta; her father, Johnny Swarer, also of Coweta; her Granny and Papa Lee, of Coweta; along with numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and friends. She was preceded in death by her brother, her hero,

Jonathan Swarer.
