John Richard Hall was born May 1, 1948, in Branson, Missouri, to John Henry “Pete” and Roberta Floy “Bert” Anderson Hall. He died Thursday, January 23, 2020, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 71 years. John completed his secondary education in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Will Rogers High School Class of 1966.
