



## Joyce Fugate

February 14, 1929 - September 20, 2015

' Marion Joyce Fugate, longtime resident of Broken Arrow, passed from this life on Sunday, September 20, 2015, at the Homestead of Owasso at the age of 86. Joyce was born February 14, 1929, in Pawhuska, Oklahoma, to Troy and May (Crockett) McDorman.
