Kaitlyn was a courageous warrior as she battled through the devastating illness of Diffuse Midline Glioma (DMG) H3K27 Mutation. This rare and aggressive mutation made her journey extraordinarily difficult, yet she faced every moment with strength and gentleness far beyond her years. Even through this incredibly difficult time, she displayed deep love for her Savior, her family, and everyone with whom she came in contact.

Every aspect of Kaitlyn's personality was awesomely and wonderfully formed by the hand of God. She was thankful for every day and continued to encourage others throughout her fight. She was highly creative, hilariously funny, and her laughter was unforgettable, warm, genuine, and often contagious. God used a full palette when painting Kaitlyn's character. While a meticulous planner and prodigious maker of lists, she was also full of big ideas and quick to embrace the moment, all while extending grace and compassion to all that God brought into her life.

There were many things in Kaitlyn's life that she found joy in, and reading was one of them. She was an avid reader whose favorite books included *A Tale of Despereaux*, *Seeker*, *The One and Only Ivan* series, and the *American Dog* series. She also enjoyed reading for laughs with *The Far Side*, *Calvin and*

Hobbes, knock-knock jokes, and the newspaper funny papers with Pops. She was a fan of Army football and enjoyed watching the Black Knights with her dad, as well as spa days on the patio with mom. She cherished family meals, delighting in the sweet contrast of her favorite treats, her love for simple vanilla ice cream balanced perfectly by a passion for rich chocolate shakes, along with YaYa's cinnamon rolls, hot cocoa, steak, and spaghetti.

Kaitlyn loved family time, friends, outdoor activities, and games. She enjoyed the weekly Family Friday night carpet picnics with movies and popcorn. She adored spending time with her friends, being outside, and playing with her dogs Daisy and Maisy, Emma, and of course Squishmallows. Kaitlyn was very active and liked jumping on her trampoline, swimming or snorkeling, snow skiing, riding bikes and scooters, collecting stickers, and drawing. She also enjoyed playing board games and card games such as Moose Match Mayhem, Taco Cat Goat Pizza, Uno, Sequence, and Qwirkle.

Some people have a love of music; Kaitlyn's life was music. Whenever and whatever she heard, from Praise and Worship to dramatic Broadway to 80's Europop, she instantly became one with the rhythm. Kaitlyn's immersion in and expression of music was the choreography of her life. Her natural rhythm, beat, and spunky, ultra-bright personality came alive the moment she heard a song, and her flair for performing drew others into the joy, fun, and radiant energy lifting all those around.

Kaitlyn was an exceptionally talented artist and enjoyed all kinds of arts and crafts. She could paint, draw, and write stories, books, and cartoons, often finding inspiration for her creations during her many travels.
