Karen Chamberlain, 70 years old, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, September 5, 2025, of complications from Progressive Aphasia Dementia.

While Kathy was born just 14 minutes earlier, Karen rarely missed a chance to claim she was the youngest. Toni, their older sister, often showed off "the twins", as everyone called them. She also interpreted their "twin speak" for their parents.

Karen graduated from McLain High School in 1973 and in 1982 welcomed twin boys, Brett and Brian, who kept her on her toes.

Thirty years ago she met her fiancé, Marty. Throughout the years they went on many vacations and enjoyed trips to the casino.

She has five grandchildren, Alyssa, Blake, Kynzie, Miles, and Raia. She loved spending time with them. One of her greatest joys was raising her oldest granddaughter, Alyssa, who she considered her best friend.

Karen was known for her quick wit and wicked sense of humor. She told the

funniest stories, which often made tears run down your face.

Karen was preceded in death by her parents, Perry and Jacque Denton, and her son, Brian Chamberlain.
