Kay Buford Dallas Johns was born May 23, 1937, in Helena, Arkansas, to Guy Otis Dallas and Ethel Maxine Grimes. She died Thursday, January 31, 2019, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 81 years. She was married June 20, 1958, in Bixby, Oklahoma, to Gerald Johns. Kay completed her secondary education in Tulsa and was a graduate of Tulsa Central High School. Kay spent most of her working life as a licensed practical nurse at St. Francis Hospital and Hillcrest Hospital.

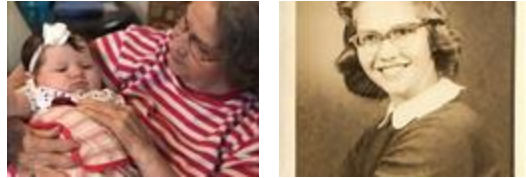
