Leland Virgil Sapcut was born in Apache, OK on July 7, 1927 to George and Blanche (Koassechony) Sapcut. He was married to Leda Turner in Tulsa, enjoying 47 years together and raising their seven children. His hobbies included coaching his son's baseball teams, playing and coaching in the slow-pitch softball league with his postal buddies, loading up the neighborhood and going boating and camping at the lake. He especially enjoyed fishing with his grandkids and attending their sporting events.
