' Linda Ann (Thacker) Walker, longtime resident of Owasso, passed from this life on Tuesday afternoon June 21, 2016 at her home. She was 76 years of age. Linda was born February 18, 1940 in Oakland, California to Clarence and Alis (Smallwood) Thacker. Because of her father's military service, they lived in a variety of locations. They eventually lived in Crescent City, CA where she graduated from Del Norte high school. On September 15, 1957, Linda and Glenn F. Walker were united in marriage. During their married life, they made their home in Crescent City, CA and later in Fallon, Nevada. In 1964 they moved to Bartlesville, OK and later to Tulsa before making their home in Owasso in 1979. Linda was a freelance court reporter for many years; she also enjoyed painting, sewing and quilting. She was also a member of the Tulsa Town Tolors and had served as president of the group.
