Lois Jean Cunningham was born August 11, 1941, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to Sam and Helen Franz Jost. She died Saturday, February 22, 2020, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 78 years. Jean was reared and educated in Owasso, Oklahoma, and graduated with the Owasso High School Class of 1959. She was married December 19, 1958, at the Westport Mennonite Brethren Church, now Discovery Bible Church, in Collinsville, Oklahoma, to Jerry Cunningham.
