Loretta Elizabeth Emmerson was born September 25, 1930, in St. Elizabeth, Missouri, to Lambert Aloysius Buechter and Elizabeth J. Evers Buechter. She died Saturday, March 16, 2024

in Collinsville, Oklahoma, at the age of 93 years. Loretta completed her secondary education in St. Elizabeth, Missouri, and graduated with the St. Elizabeth High School Class of 1947.
