Louise Evelyn Nelson was born June 27, 1918, in Wagoner County, Oklahoma, to Frank Lesley and Cora Bell (Logan) Adams. She died Friday, August 1, 2014, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 96 years. Louise moved with her parents to Tulsa, Oklahoma, in 1926, where she was reared and educated, graduating with the Central High School Class of 1936. She continued her education attending Kansas City Junior College then Denver Bible Institute. She was married Valentine's Day, February 14, 1940, in Nebraska City, Nebraska, to Reverend Luther M. Nelson. She spent much of her working life as a homemaker but also fulfilled the role of pastor's wife with her husband while he pastored churches in Oklahoma, Missouri, and Kansas. Louise and her husband made their home at the Baptist Village of Owasso in 1984. She was a faithful member of First Baptist Church in Owasso, but throughout her Christian service she was active from the nursery to classroom teaching.
