Lynn Wilfred Hanover was born May 15, 1932 in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Earl Lloyd Hanover and Alma Olivia (Iverson) Hanover. He passed from this life Thursday, April 19, 2018, in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years. Lynn was raised and educated in Tulsa and graduated with the Central High School Class of 1950. After high school, Lynn served his country honorably in the United States Army during the Korean conflict. Soon after he was discharged, on December 23, 1955 Lynn married Donella Marie Hulsizer.
