Lynn Edward Wedemeyer was born on March 19, 1948 in Atlantic, Iowa to Walter Wedemeyer and Elaine Ruby (Smith) Wedemeyer. He died on Friday, January 1, 2021 in Tulsa, Oklahoma at the age of 72 years. He was raised and educated in Adair, Iowa where he graduated with the Adair-Casey High School Class of 1966.
