Mae Belle Reed was born June 30, 1927, near Oxford, Kansas, to Orie C. and Mamie Belle Wheeler Lucas. She died Tuesday, November 6, 2018, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 91 years. Mae Belle was the middle child of 13 and at the age of 4 yrs was given by the Lord's design, to another family to be raised. The Millers, JB and Hattie, including one dear brother, Delmont, became her new family. Mae Belle was reared and educated in Oxford, Kansas, and graduated with the Oxford High School Class of 1945.
