Marcel Emil Polge, Jr. was born on October 5, 1929, in Lexington, Missouri to Marcel Emil Polge, Sr. and Vera Mae (Simmons) Polge. He passed from this life on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, in Owasso, Oklahoma at the age of 95 years. Marcel was raised and educated in Lexington, MO and graduated with the Lexington, High School Class of 1947. He then enlisted and served his country honorably in the United States Air Force where he spent 4 years in Active Duty U.S. Air Force. Marcel served 2 years at MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa, Florida and 2 years at Ramey Air Force Base in Puerto Rico. Marcel was married on October 13, 1952, in Tulsa, Oklahoma to Juanita Ione (Purkey) Polge. He earned his A and P mechanic certificate from Spartan School of Aeronautics in Tulsa. Marcel spent most of his working life as an airline mechanic with American Airlines for 32 years. During his lunch breaks, he frequently held Bible Studies and shared the gospel on his lunch breaks at American Airlines. He was a longtime faithful member of Faith Lutheran Church in Owasso, OK. In earlier years in Tulsa, OK, he served at Grace Lutheran and Our Savior Lutheran.
