



## Marian M. Warren Boley

July 26, 1911 - October 21, 2014

'Marian M. (Warren) Boley passed into the arms of Jesus on Tuesday, October 21, 2014, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 103. She was born July 26, 1911, in Matador, Texas, to Claud William and Pearl Elizabeth (Callison) Warren. Marian completed her secondary education at Matador, Texas, and graduated with the Matador High School Class of 1928. She attended Hardin Simmons College for a year and a half in pursuit of a Speech and Drama degree. She was married to Glynn W. Boley on June 10, 1930, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, where they also made their home. After beginning their family, they eventually moved to Ada, Oklahoma, in 1943 for Glynn to become the Manager of Central Dairy Products. After their children were raised, they began spending their summers at Lake Texoma and creating many special memories for their grandchildren and great grandchildren before moving to Hobbs, New Mexico, in the latter years of their life together. Due to her husband contracting tuberculosis in his job, Marian helped support her family by briefly working as an appliance salesperson as well as demonstrating their use by running a cooking school for Whittles Appliance in Ada. However, her most important job was always that of homemaker and caring for her family. She was a faithful member of the First United Methodist Church, both in Hobbs and Ada. She loved to travel and sing with the Jubilee Choir. She enjoyed a variety of pastimes including tending her flower garden which was always full of beautiful blooms, traveling with friends, fishing, playing cards and dominoes, cheering on the OU football team with her husband as season

ticket holders for 35 years and cooking delicious meals not only for the cooking school at Whittles but also for friends and family. She most recently referred to herself as a happy old lady and those who knew her or only just met her would readily agree.
