Mary Ann Lewis was born June 29, 1940, in Fairland, Oklahoma, to Calvin Harding Houk and Gladys Marguerite Williams Houk. She transitioned to Heaven on Monday, November 4, 2024, in Tulsa, Oklahoma, at the age of 84 years.
