'Mary Ruth Nachtigall was born March 4, 1924, in Hooker, Oklahoma, to Abraham Frantz and Sarah (Cornelson) Fast. She died Sunday, June 7, 2015, in Collinsville, Oklahoma, at the age of 91 years. Mary was reared and educated at Adams, Oklahoma, and was a graduated of Adams High School. She was married September 14, 1941, at Adams to Alvin Nachtigall.
